NATIONAL GUARD?

Citizen-Soldier:

The Army National Guard is composed primarily of traditional Guardsmen -- civilians who serve their country, state and community on a part-time basis.

- One weekend per month and two week annual training.
- Part-time service, full-time student
- Can start as early as 17 years of age.

State Mission:

The governor, through the state Adjutant General, can call the National Guard into action during local or statewide emergencies.

- Storms
- Earthquakes
- Civil disturbances
- Counterdrug
- Fires
- Floods

Federal Mission:

The President of the United States can activate the National Guard for participation in federal missions.

- Deployments
 - Middle East and other locations in the war on terrorism
- National Emergencies
 - Natural Disasters
 - Homeland Security

\$300 for Freshmen; \$350 for Sophomores; \$450 for Juniors; \$500 for Seniors


Annual \$1,200 Book Stipend \$600 per Semester
